More Data. We added more data in 2023 including 18 new whole genome assembly, QTL, markers, genetic map, genotype, and phenotype data. We also started adding GWAS data and added more expression data! Check the 'Data Overview' page for currently available data.

New and Updated Tools. <u>MegaSearch</u> and <u>MapViewer</u> are updated to display GWAS data, and the <u>Expression Heatmap</u> allows researchers to quickly and easily identify patterns of gene expression that are associated with specific conditions or treatments.
